

Throw Pillow based on Fossils in Animal Crossing: New Horizons

Materials:

2 skeins of Lion Brand Hometown USA: Fort Worth Blue (269 g)
(Less than) 1 skein of Lion Brand Hometown USA: New York White (39 g)

Stuffing

K hook

2 removable place markers or scrap yarn

Scissors

Yarn needle to sew pillow together and weave in ends

Stitches:

(Uses US crochet terms)

mc: magic circle

sc: single crochet

hdc: half double crochet

dc: double crochet

sc2tog: single crochet 2 together

sl st: slip stitch

pm: place marker

sm: slip marker

Special stitches used for shell applique: see Shell, below

Gauge: not important - just make sure the fabric is tight enough that stuffing won't come out between the stitches

Size: sample is about 12" tall

Main pillow:

Start with a magic circle

R1: sc 6 into magic circle, join with sl st (6 stitches)

R2: Ch 1, pm, *sc 1, (sc 2 in same st), (sc 2 in same st)* twice (10)

Keep working in a spiral

R3: *(2 sc in same st), sc 1* around (15)

R4: *(2 sc in same st), sc 2* around (20)

R5: *(2 sc in same st), sc 3* around (25)

R6: *(2 sc in same st), sc 4* around (30)

R7: *(2 sc in same st), sc 5* around (35)

R8: *(2 sc in same st), sc 6* around (40)

R9: sc around

R10: *(2 sc in same st), sc 7* around (45)

R11: sc around

R12: *(2 sc in same st), sc 8* around (50)

R13: sc around

R14: *(2 sc in same st), sc 9* around (55)

R15: sc around

R16: sc around

R17: *(2 sc in same st), sc 10* around (60)

R18-R31: sc around

Flatten pillow to find where you want the front and back to be, then place markers at the folds on the left and right. Continue (sc around) until you get to one of the markers.

R32-36: sm, sc 2, sc2tog, sc to 3 before marker, sc2 tog, sc 1, sm, sc 2, sc2tog, sc to 3 before marker, sc2tog, sc 1

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew the pillow closed later

Make the shell, 5-pointed star, and 4-pointed star, then sew them onto pillow before stuffing and sewing shut.



Note: I think this layout looks better than where I actually sewed the stars.

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Shell:

Special stitches:

Stitch A: yo twice, insert hook in next stitch, yo, pull yarn up, yo, pull through 2 loops on the hook, yo, pull through all 3 loops on the hook

Stitch B: yo twice, insert hook in next stitch, yo, pull yarn up, (yo, pull through 2 loops on the hook) 3 times

Start with a magic circle

R1: ch 1, hdc 6 into magic circle, join with sl st (6 stitches)

R2: ch 2, (2 dc in same st) around (12)

Work in a spiral

Work all stitches into the 3rd loop for the rest of the shell

R3: *(2 dc in same st), dc 1* around (18)

R4a: (2 A in same st) around, but only go 3/4 of the way around

R4b: (2 B in same st) for 1/4 of the way around

Final stitches: (2 B in same st) once, then fasten off

Leave a long tail to sew the shell onto the main pillow

5-Pointed Star:

Start with a magic circle

R1: ch 1, sc 10 into magic circle, join with sl st (10)

R2: *sl st, ch 3, sl st in 3rd chain from hook, sl st into next stitch* around

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew onto pillow

4-Pointed Star:

Start with a magic circle

R1: Working into magic circle, *sl st, ch 3, sl st in 3rd chain from hook, sl st into magic circle* 4 times

Close magic circle and fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew onto pillow

Finishing:

Sew the shell, 5-pointed star, and 4-pointed star to the front of the pillow.

Sew the pillow most of the way closed by drawing the needle through the front loop of each stitch from outside to inside, alternating sides of the pillow opening.

Stuff pillow, then finish sewing the pillow shut.

Fasten off after last stitch, pull the needle through the pillow to hide the end, and cut end.
