

# Pie Duck Crochet Pattern



Left to right: duck without lattice crust, duck with lattice crust, example for attaching the lattice to the filling so it stays in place

## Stitch abbreviations:

Note: pattern uses US terminology

mc = magic circle

ch = chain stitch

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

tr = treble crochet

hdc = half double crochet

inv dec = invisible decrease (sc2tog through front loops only)

sl st = slip stitch

sk st = skip stitch

## Supplies:

Yarn in two colors: tan for the crust and any color for the pie filling

I used Red Heart Super Saver in buff and cherry red

Approx 15-20 g of tan and 10-15 g of filling color

Stuffing

H hook: gauge doesn't matter as long as stuffing doesn't come out between the stitches

Stitch markers or scrap yarn

Scissors

Yarn needle

## Pie crust:

Ruffle = sk st, (4 hdc in same stitch), sk st, slip stitch

R1: magic circle, sc 6, join, ch 1

R2: (2 sc in same stitch) around (12)

R3: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 1\* around (18)

R4: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 2\* around (24)

R5: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 3\* around (30)

R6: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 4\* around (36)

R7: In 3rd loop only: sc around (36)

R8: Sc around

R9: Sc around

R10: Sc around

R11: Ch 1, ruffle, sk st, (3 hdc in same stitch), (3 dc in same stitch), (3 trc in same stich), (dc, hdc in same stitch), sl st, 3 ruffles, (hdc, dc in same stitch), (3 trc in same stitch), (3 dc in same stitch), (3 hdc in same stitch), sk st, sl st, ruffle, sk st, (hdc, dc, ch 1, dc, hdc in same stitch), sk st, sl st, fasten off

## Duck head:

Make sure to stuff before

R1: magic circle, sc 6, join, ch 1

R2: (2 sc in same stitch) around (12)

R3: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 1\* around (18)

R4: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 2\* around (24)

R5: sc around (24)

R6: sc around (24)

R7: \*inv dec, sc 2\* around (18)

R8: \*inv dec, sc 1\* around (12)

R9: inv dec around (6)

Fasten off, thread through remaining 6 stitches, tie knot

Leave a long tail to sew on

## Pie filling:

R1: Magic circle, sc 6, join

R2: (2 sc in same stitch) around (12)

R3: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 1\* around (18)

R4: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 2\* around (24)

R5: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 3\* around (30)

R6: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 4\* around (36)

If the filling is wide enough to sew to row 10 of the pie crust, fasten off

If there's still a large gap, then do row 7:

R7: \*(2 sc in same stitch), sc 5\* around (42), fasten off

## Beak:

R1: magic circle, sc 6, join, ch 1

R2: sc 6, join, fasten off

## Lattice (make 5):

Make loose chain stitches until the chain is slightly longer than the distance across the pie filling, fasten off

## Putting the pie duck together:

1. Pull the ends of the chains through the edges of the pie filling piece to hold them in place. Weave the strips over-under-over-under to create the woven lattice look.
2. Sew the head to the filling near the edge.
3. Line up the head with the front of the crust (the middle of the 3 ruffles) and sew the filling to Row 10 of the crust. If your pie has a lattice, make sure to sew through the chains to anchor them in place more securely.
4. Sew the beak onto the front of the head.
